JUDGMENT ENTRY  
NUNC PRO TUNC

This matter is before the Court upon defendant's motion to correct the record, which was filed on January 11, 2005. The Court finds the motion well taken, and the motion is granted as hereinafter set forth.

The matter heard by the Magistrate was the grounds for the divorce.

1. This Court has reviewed the Magistrate's Decision, defendant's objections to same, and the transcript filed. Defendant's objections are not well taken; defendant's objections are denied.

2. After a review of the Magistrate's Decision and an independent analysis of the issues, findings of fact, and the application of the rules applicable thereto, the Court finds there is no error of law or other defect on the face of the Magistrate's Decision and hereby approves and adopts the same, and orders it filed for record.

3. The parties' current mailing and residence and residence telephone numbers are in the Shared Parenting Decree. The parties' dates of birth, Social Security numbers, driver's license numbers and income sources are all in the Shared Parenting Decree.

4. The Court finds that both the parties were residents of the State of Ohio for more than six (6) months immediately preceding the filing of the complaint; the parties were married on August 2, 1997; one child was born as a result of the marriage, namely Christopher Nolan, DOB 3/99.

5. The Court further finds that the parties have lived separate and apart for more than one year without cohabitation, and that by reason thereof the plaintiff is entitled to a divorce.

6. The Court finds that the parties reached an agreement as to the allocation of certain debts and assets as set forth in the Agreed Order filed October 8, 2003. The Court further finds that this Agreed Order disposed of all of the assets and debts of the parties. The Agreed Order filed October 8, 2003, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference and marked Court's Exhibit A.

7. The Court further finds the parties entered into a Shared Parenting Plan. The parties also filed a Shared Parenting Decree on December 2, 2003. The Shared Parenting Decree and Plan are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference and marked **Court's Exhibit B.**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:**

8. The Magistrate's Decision is hereby adopted.

9. The marriage contract heretofore existing between the parties be and it is hereby dissolved and set aside.

10. The allocation of assets and debts shall be pursuant to the Agreed Order filed October 8, 2003, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as though fully rewritten and marked **Court's Exhibit A.**

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:**

11. Determination as to parental rights shall be pursuant to the Shared Parenting Decree and Shared Parenting Plan, which was filed on December 2, 2003, and is also attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as though fully rewritten, and marked **Court's Exhibit B.**

12. The parties shall share the costs of these proceedings equally; judgment is rendered for the costs; execution may issue on the judgment.
